SYNODAL PROCESS SYNTHESIS: The synodal conversations were rich both online throughout the Diocesan and parish survey links and in-person for groups gathering in parishes, parish halls, schools, campuses, or elsewhere. The amount of input, feedback, and heartfelt engagement was outstanding, especially given the ongoing challenges posed by the pandemic. The *Synodal Process Synthesis* from the Roman Catholic Diocese of Peterborough was submitted to the Assembly of Catholic Bishops of Ontario on Friday, June 17th as required. They will be collating the Synthesis documents from the Ontario Arch Dioceses and forwarding them to the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops and then to the Vatican. Each Diocese across Canada has pledged a sum of money to ensure that the national financial commitment will be met. The Roman Catholic Diocese of Peterborough has agreed to pledge the sum of \$400,000. The funds will be overseen by a local committee comprising First Nations, Métis, and Inuit representation and used for these purposes:

- Healing and reconciliation for communities and families;
- Culture and language revitalization;
- · Education and community building; and
- Dialogues for promoting indigenous spirituality and culture.
