LITURGY NOTES— YOU! OH GOD!



Continuing our examination of the liturgy piece by piece, let's think about that magnificent prayer we sing together so often: Glory to God in the highest! To find a renewed way to put your heart into this prayer, make a point of always remembering to Whom you are singing: to

God Almighty, your Creator, your Master, your Font of being, the Giver of every gift in your life, and your Father. The word "you" in the Gloria is something we can sing with love: "We praise YOU, we bless YOU, we adore YOU, we glorify YOU, we give YOU thanks for YOUR great glory!" This is praise and each "you" allows us to thrust our praise heavenward to the great God we encounter in the sacred gathering of every Mass. These are not just our words: they came from heaven. The angels were the first to sing the introduction on that first Christmas Eve: "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace." They are still singing it, and the echoes of our voices in the rafters of the Church make their praise audible.

After praising the Father, our voices shift to praise of the Son, and petition for mercy, and pleading for our prayers to be heard. The Gloria is rounded out by a return to praise of Jesus: YOU alone are the Holy One, YOU alone are the Lord every "you" again launching from our hearts to heaven, praising Jesus. The Holy Spirit, who has been stirring up our hearts throughout the hymn of praise, is included in our final words, as we participate in the inner life of worship of Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In the Gloria, that hymn of praise which we sing so often in worship, God provides us a portal of praise to draw our hearts to him. Always remember to Whom you are singing, as your own words rise to the Creator who gave you your voice: YOU alone are the Holy One, YOU alone are the Lord.
