SUBJECT: FIRST HOLY COMMUNION (1st Reconciliation / 1st Eucharist)

I wish to share good news with you! As a Grade Two student at Immaculate Conception Elementary or Monsignor O'Donoghue, your child is a potential candidate for the reception of the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist.

With the support and engagement of you as parents, the parish, and the Catholic school community, I look forward to assisting your child in their preparation to receive these sacraments.

The Diocese of Peterborough has brought the parishes together to offer a *Sacramental Preparation Program* that is consistent in form and content. This initiative is designed to assist the home, school and parish in nurturing the faith of your child as you prepare them for receiving these sacraments.

All of the Catholic parishes in the Diocese work closely with the school communities. The Catholic schools provide *Religious and Family Life Education* for your child and the parishes provide the *Sacramental Preparation Programs*. Catechists from the parish community facilitate the *Sacramental Preparation Program* with your child. This program is required for your child to understand the significance of the sacraments and to receive these sacraments this year.

The following are the details for the **First Holy Communion** program being offered at Immaculate Conception Parish. All sessions will be held from 4:30 to 6:00 p.m. in the parish hall:

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

- Wednesday, October 18th
- Wednesday, November 8th
- Wednesday, November 29th
- Wednesday, January 10th
- Wednesday, January 24th (Retreat)

Celebration of First Reconciliation: Wednesday, January 31st

SACRAMENT OF EUCHARIST

- Wednesday, February 21st
- Wednesday, March 20th
- Wednesday, April 17th
- Wednesday, May 1st
- Saturday, May 25th (Retreat)

First Holy Communion Mass: Sunday, June 09, 2023 at 9:00 a.m.


There is a fee of \$50 to help offset the cost of the materials. Your child will receive two books, *Signs of Grace You are Forgiven—Reconciliation* and *Signs of Grace You are Loved—Eucharist*. Kindly bring the completed registration form, their baptism certificate and the fee **to the parish office before the first session on October 18th**.
