ST. ALPHONSUS LIGOURI EVENTS:



- 1) **SONSHINE ADORATION** is an opportunity for parents to bring their young children to be in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. This is a time for the children to play freely (no running around however), colour, read, and do activities in the glorious sight of our Lord. The Monstrance is set on a small table, so it is relatively close to the children's level of interaction. SonShine Adoration will take place after the 9:00 a.m. Mass, from 9:30 to 10:30, every third Friday of the month, starting **September 19**th.
- 2) YOUTH MINISTRY is starting up as well. This Ministry for grades 6-8, is called Club 316, and happens every Friday night from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. The Ministry for grades 9-12, is called Catalyst, and runs on Tuesday nights from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. The evening will start off with games, a FULL MEAL (free), then a message video, and small group discussion. - 3) **DIVINE MERCY PROGRAM** is held the third Tuesday of each month at 2:30 p.m. in St. Alphonsus church for an hour of Adoration, the Rosary, Confession and of course, the *Divine Mercy Chaplet*—a very powerful, spiritual hour of prayer. Starting **September 16**th.

LITURGY NOTES— WORD & SACRAMENT



There are two principal parts of every Mass: The *Liturgy of the Word* and the *Liturgy of the Eucharist*. They are preceded and followed by short opening and closing rites that spiritually lead us to and away from this two-fold essence of the Mass. In the *Liturgy of the Word*, we

believe that God is speaking to us afresh every time we hear the scriptures proclaimed, most especially when the words of Jesus sound again in the ears of the Church with every Gospel; then, in the *Liturgy of the Eucharist*, we believe that it is the very same Lord who has spoken to us through his Word who becomes really and substantially present in the Eucharist we receive.

One way to think about the relationship between the *Liturgy of the Word* and the *Liturgy of the Eucharist* is that these particular holy scriptures that I am hearing today are preparing me to receive the Lord at this particular Mass. This is all the more reason to pay attention and even cherish every word of the scriptures proclaimed, knowing that you are being prepared to receive the very Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus, being disposed to all the graces that you might be able to receive on this day of your life.

Then receive the Lord with an ever-deeper sense of awe and wonder that you are partaking of the body of Jesus who hung on the Cross for you, was raised from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the Father. Jesus Christ, Son of God, Saviour: this is whom you receive in Holy Communion, and it is an awesome thing beyond mere human comprehension. After Communion, be sure to say prayers of thanksgiving that God has blessed us with this awesome way to be filled with every grace and heavenly blessing. Then go forth and bring this good news to all those God brings into your life.

LA VERNA: Summer is waning as Autumn shows her colours. La Verna Ministries (820 Frank Street) have taken nature's cue and offer Autumn Programming. *Discovering Franciscan Spirituality* is a program of personal spiritual development. *MEDITATIO* offers the participant a one-hour experience of Contemplative Prayer in the Franciscan tradition.
