SUBJECT: SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

I wish to share good news with you! As a Grade Seven student at Immaculate Conception Elementary or Monsignor O'Donoghue, your child is a potential candidate for the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation.

With the support and engagement of you as parents, the parish, and the Catholic school community, I look forward to assisting your child in their preparation to receive this sacrament.

The Diocese of Peterborough has brought the parishes together to offer a *Sacramental Preparation Program* that is consistent in form and content. This initiative is designed to assist the home, school and parish in nurturing the faith of your child as you prepare them for receiving this sacrament.

All of the Catholic parishes in the Diocese work closely with the school communities. The Catholic schools provide *Religious and Family Life Education* for your child and the parishes provide the *Sacramental Preparation Programs*. Catechists from the parish community facilitate the *Sacramental Preparation Program* with your child. This program is required for your child to understand the significance of the sacrament and to receive this sacrament this year.

The following are the details for the **Confirmation** program being offered at Immaculate Conception Parish. All sessions will be held from 4:30 to 6:00 p.m. in the parish hall:

There is a fee of \$50 to help offset the cost of the materials. Your child will receive a student guide entitled: *Chosen: Your Journey Toward Confirmation*. Kindly bring the completed registration form, their baptism certificate and the fee **to the parish office before the first session on January 22nd**.
