- 2,672.3 pounds of food delivered to the SSVP Food Pantry from parishioners' donations and Immaculate Conception School food drives.
- Monthly SSVP collection: \$ 16,245, including donations from Our Lady of Assumption Parish.
- Sent up to SSVP Particular Council: \$10,500 for the operation of the Food Pantry and the stores.
- 40 Cans For 40 Days Lenten collection.
- Supported financially Immaculate Conception and Monsignor O'Donoghue School Breakfast programme and food for dinners at One Roof Centre.
- Twinning with St Pius X SSVP conference has been discontinued due to the end of their mandate. Now twinning with our Lady of the Universe Conference at St. Michael's parish in Barbados and supporting with \$1,000 a year.
- Now back volunteering at the food pantry and store after Covid restrictions.
- Christmas food hampers were provided to seven needy families at Immaculate Conception school.
