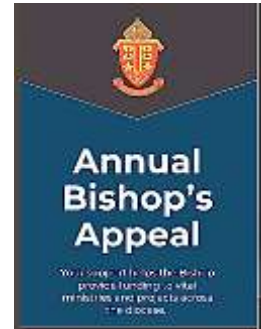

Saint Maria Goretti - Feast Day July 6th



At just eleven years old, Saint Maria Goretti showed extraordinary faith, purity, and courage. Born into a poor family in Italy, she helped care for her younger siblings and perform household duties. When she resisted repeated advances from a young man named Alessandro Serenelli, she was brutally attacked and fatally wounded. Before her death, Maria forgave her attacker and expressed her hope that he would one day be with her in Heaven.

Maria's witness of faith, mercy, and forgiveness quickly inspired devotion among the faithful. Canonized in 1950 by Pope Pius XII, she remains a powerful example of Christian forgiveness and the hope that even the most hardened sinner can repent and be saved. Her life challenges us to deepen our own capacity for mercy and trust in God's grace.
